Students who have demonstrated longevity in the department (3-4 years of participation), participated in extra curricular honors ensembles (Morris Area Honor Choir, Region I Choir, All-State Ensembles), and/or served as a choir officer are more highly considered. The Outstanding Choral Senior Awards are given to four deserving graduating seniors each year.

Ivan W. Baker Choral Award (1; monetary scholarship)

The Ivan W. Baker Award is given in recognition of exemplary merit, ability, degree of loyalty, and achievement, as well as of outstanding contributions to the success of the Morris Hills Vocal Music Department. Students should have demonstrated longevity in the department (3-4 years of participation), participated in extra curricular honors ensembles (Morris Area Honor Choir, Region I Choir, All-State Ensembles), and/or served as a choir officer are more highly considered. The Ivan W. Baker Choral Award is given to one extraordinary graduating senior each year.
